

What size cable tray should I choose

- 4. Future Expansion** Add approximately 25% spare capacity to accommodate future cable additions without requiring a new tray.
- 5. Depth vs. Width** Increasing tray width generally improves airflow and cable pulling efficiency more than increasing depth. Ladder trays prioritize width and side rail height for heavy loads, while perforated or wire mesh trays balance containment with ventilation.
- 6. Load Capacity and Material** Tray thickness and material affect load-bearing capacity. Heavy-duty trays typically require 2.5mm or thicker galvanized steel with reinforced side rails to support large cable bundles.
- 7. Installation Environment** Consider space constraints, temperature, humidity, chemical exposure, and clearance requirements. Specialized trays, such as stainless steel, may be needed in corrosive or hygienic environments.
