

Wiring connections for the home electrical distribution box

Mount the Box: Secure the distribution box on a dry, accessible wall at a recommended height (~1.5 meters) with proper ventilation.
Connect Incoming Supply:
Live (Phase) wire: Connect to the main switch or main terminal.
Neutral wire: Connect to the neutral bus bar.
Earth wire: Connect to the earth bus bar for grounding.
Install Circuit Breakers: Place the MCBs or RCDs in their designated slots. Ensure each breaker matches the load rating of the circuit it protects.
Connect Outgoing Circuits: Route each circuit wire to its corresponding breaker.
Connect the neutral and earth wires to their respective bus bars.
Label each circuit for easy identification and future maintenance.
Check Wire Ratings and Insulation: Use wires of appropriate gauge for the load, ensure proper i...
