- Control and Signal Wiring:** Connect the CNC controller to the power supply and motor drivers. Wire limit switches, emergency stop buttons, and other sensors according to the wiring diagram. Keep signal wires separate from high-power lines to prevent electromagnetic interference.
- Grounding and Shielding:** Use a star grounding configuration: connect all ground wires to a single...
