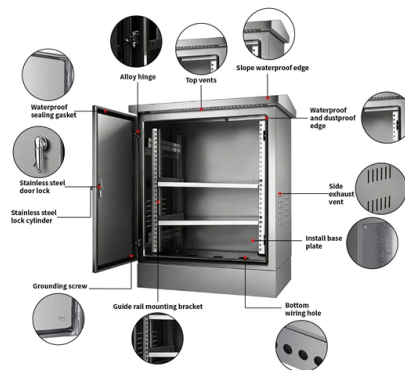


Wiring of primary secondary and tertiary power distribution boxes on construction site

- Equipment:** Large three-phase circuit breakers and RCDs for area-specific protection .
- Connections:** Inner and outer doors, powder-coated exteriors, and rainproof tops for outdoor use .
- Function:** Acts as an intermediate distribution point, forming the second tier of protection in the system.
- Load Management:** Designed to handle multiple tertiary boxes or equipment circuits, ensuring balanced load distribution.
