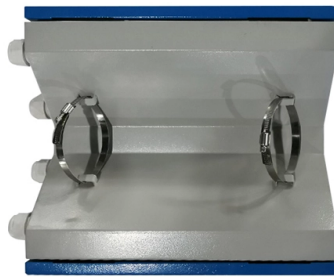


Wiring of the fan distribution box

Proper fan distribution box wiring ensures safe operation, correct phase connections, and compliance with electrical codes.

Key Considerations

- 1. Use a Fan-Rated Electrical Box:** Ensure the box is rated to support the fan's weight and vibration. Ceiling or exhaust fans require boxes that meet NEC 314.27(C), supporting at least 35–50 lbs, unlike standard light fixture boxes. Secure the box to a ceiling joist or support brace for stability.

- 3. Three-Phase Fan Wiring (Industrial Fans):** For three-phase fans, all fans on the same control stage must use the same phase and polarity configuration. Connect the power-in wires, relay control wires, and fan motor wires according to the wiring diagram for your voltage. Cap all unused wires to meet electrical codes. Use color-coded wires and tables to track connections for each stage.
- 4. Wire Sizing and Circuit Protection:** For standard 120V ceiling fans, use 14 AWG copper wire on a 15A breaker. For separate fan and light control, use 14/3 cable (hot, neutral, traveler, ground). For longer runs, consider voltage drop; upsize wire if the drop exceeds 3%.
- 5. Wiring Steps:** Turn off power at the breaker and verify the circuit is de-energized. Remove the existing box if replacing, and inspect wiring. Strip wire ends and connect hot, neutral, and ground wires. For three-phase fans, follow the manufacturer's wiring diagram for phase alignment and relay connections. Secure all connections inside the box, ensuring wires are organized and capped. Attach the fan mounting bracket to the box and mount the fan. Test the fan operation before finalizing the installation.
- 6. Safety and Compliance:** Always follow local, regional, and national electrical codes. Use a voltage tester to confirm circuits are de-energized before working. Ensure all unused wires a...
