

Wiring of the winch distribution box

Connect Main Power Run a heavy-gauge positive cable from the battery's positive terminal to the input post on the solenoid box. Install a fuse or circuit breaker in-line near the battery to protect the circuit. Connect a main negative (ground) cable from the battery's negative terminal to the solenoid's ground post or a clean chassis ground.

Connect Motor Terminals Use four short, heavy-gauge cables to connect the solenoid posts to the winch motor terminals, typically labeled A (Armature), F1, F2 (Field), and Motor Ground. These connections allow the solenoid to reverse polarity for bidirectional operation.

Control Wiring Connect the lighter-gauge wires from the wired remote or toggle switch to the low-amp terminals on the solenoid. This control circuit signals the solenoid to engage the relays and switch the main power flow.

Secure and Protect Wiring Route all cables away from moving parts, heat sources, and sharp edges. Use zip ties, abrasion sleeves, or conduit to prevent chafing and short circuits. Ensure all connections are clean, corrosion-free, and tightened firmly.

Testing Reconnect the battery's negative terminal. Test the winch without a load by spooling the cable in and out. Verify smooth operation in both directions and correct drum rotation. Listen for unusual sounds or delays, which may indicate loose connections or incorrect wiring.
