

Wiring requirements for construction site distribution boxes

Conductors can be run as multiconductor cords, inside raceways, or as open conductors on insulators spaced no more than 10 feet apart. Open conductors are only allowed where they are protected from physical damage. Cables should be secured, insulated, and organized to prevent tripping hazards and mechanical damage.
4. Box Selection and Placement: Choose a distribution box suitable for the environment (indoor/outdoor) with appropriate IP or NEMA ratings. Install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation, typically at a height of around 1.5 meters. The enclosure should protect internal components from dust, water, and impact.
5. Testing and Maintenance: Before energizing, perform visual inspections and multimeter tests to verify correct wiring, grounding, and breaker operation. Temporary wiring should be regularly inspected...
