

Wiring sequence for crimped network patch panels

The color sequences are: T568A: Pin 1: White/Green Pin 2: Green Pin 3: White/Orange Pin 4: Blue Pin 5: White/Blue Pin 6: Orange Pin 7: White/Brown Pin 8: Brown T568B: Pin 1: White/Orange Pin 2: Orange Pin 3: White/Green Pin 4: Blue Pin 5: White/Blue Pin 6: Green Pin 7: White/Brown Pin 8: Brown.

Insert Wires into Patch Panel Slots Place each wire into its corresponding slot on the back of the patch panel according to the chosen standard. This step helps identify miswiring before connecting to network devices. **Organize and Secure Cables** Attach the patch panel to the rack or cabinet....
